
HOW DOES IT WORK?

About this course

This course is **foundation training** for artists who want to learn black and grey fine line tattooing in Libby Wells' **signature style**.

This course Is suitable for artists wanting to enhance their skill set by adding Fine Line, Black and Grey Tattooing to their repertoire. You will be expected to provide a high quality portfolio demonstrating artistic abilities, this portfolio will need to pass a strict assessment process.





COMPLETION EXPECTED TO TAKE BETWEEN 6 MONTH - 1 YEAR.

The content of this course has been created piece by piece over several years by Libby Wells, she has deconstructed her techniques and reconstructed these into a **modular formula** to offer a uniquely strategic approach to learning how to create fine line tattoos.

Libby believes in a **holistic and comprehensive** approach to learning, reflected in the wide array of topics covered and depth of knowledge offered within this course.







A bit about Libby Wells

"Hey I'm Libby Wells, (and Tulip my assistant) I've been tattooing for 10 years now. People often ask me when did I decide I wanted to be a tattoo artist; the truth is this passion started before my consciousness kicked in. According to my mother, I have always loved tattoos. I would stop and stare at people with artwork on their body when I was toddling about, as soon as I discovered felt pens I was colouring in anyone who would sit still long enough.

I've been drawing and painting for as long as I can remember and have enjoyed every second. Progression is important to me and these skills have such room for growth. Every day you improve and in every way there is more to learn, I have always had a huge amount of patience and that's really half the battle. Successful tattooing skills are learnt from good foundational teaching and then perfected with hours of practice.

Tattooing Experience

As a practising artist, I have worked in Guildford, Lightwater, Richmond, Putney and Brighton before finally settling in Shoreham-by-Sea. From Ephemeral Studio, I offer the unique style of 'Fine Line & Fine Art' fusion tattooing, as well as Tiny Tattoos, Cosmetic Tattooing, Training courses, Oil Painting commissions and Consultancy support.

This course has been designed to share the fundamentals that made my success possible, sharing with you the secret tips and tricks I have learned over the years, offering a 'high end' quality result for artists and clients alike.



Three Part Process

Phase One – Theory study

You will be required to complete all theory training via the online portal. This will include in-depth studying at home and practical exercises that will be submitted for review, as you progress.

Phase Two – In-person masterclass

On completion of Phase One, you will need to complete the in-person masterclass with Libby Wells at Highbrow Academy, Dorchester. You will practice the physical application of tattoos on live models, demonstrating the knowledge learned during the theory training and practicing your new skills with the full support and direction of Libby.

Phase Three – Case studies

Once the masterclass is completed to a satisfactory standard, you will be ready to begin solo tattooing at your own premises, working as a junior tattoo artist while you gain experience in tattooing. You will be required to submit your tattoos for assessment during this 6 month period.

Once all three phases are finished to the satisfactory standard, you will have successfully completed your Foundation Training in Fine Line Tattooing and be accredited accordingly.

Requirements & Commitments

Entry Level for training

Entry level requirements for trainees -Minimum 5 GCSEs, A-C grades, including (Art GCSE) Submission of a professional artist portfolio of 10 pieces minimum.

Equipment, premises and documentation

Students will be required to supply their own equipment and premises, licence, waste transfer note & insurance, *this programme is constructed to teach students to work for themselves*. All purchases, including training, need to be recorded for students personal tax accounting. A full list of recommended equipment will be provided in the course material.

Student responsibilities

Students will be required to complete all online studies provided; all assignments need to be passed in order to proceed. Students will be required to to attend in person masterclass' with Libby Wells. This is completed over three consecutive days at Highbrow Academy in Dorchester UK, *dates will be confirmed*. Students will be required to submit case studies for final assessment.


