

Who should take this course?

People wanting to learn fine line, black and grey tattooing. This course is for beginners with no machine experience.

How much does it cost?

£8000 for the qualification

Where will I tattoo?

The training days are complete with libby in her studio in Shoreham-by-Sea. When you have finished the course you will need find a suitable premises for yourself to tattoo from, this course teaches you how to work for yourself.

How do I book this course?

Complete the application from at the bottom of this brochure. We will book you the In person course days to work towards, you pay the balance and then you are granted access via our online portal to begin your theory training.

Is this course official?

Yes, this course is accredited by CPD providing you with a qualification upon completion, though most tattoo training providers don't offer certification, we aim to go above and beyond, proving a strategic approach to tattoo education.

Are there any other costs?

You are required to purchase your own tattooing equipment circa £3000, you are provided a list of recommendation as part of the course materials.

Do I need to be good at art?

Yes, this helps massively, we all want different things from our tattoo career, some artists want to create very simple designs, some go more into illustrative pieces and some prefer to focus on a fine art style, where you take these techniques is up to you, libby will mentor you with whatever decision you choose.


HOW DOES IT WORK?

What is this course?

This course is **fully accredited**, **foundation training** for artists who want to learn black and grey fine line tattooing in Libby Wells' **signature style**.

This course Is suitable for artists wanting to enhance their skill set by adding Fine Line, Black and Grey Tattooing to their repertoire. This is a **beginners course**, teaching students how to wok for themselves.

Libby has an exemplary reputation for producing high quality fine line work, training and students.





BECOME QUALIFIED COMPLETION EXPECTED TO TAKE BETWEEN 6 MONTH - 1 YEAR.

The content of this course has been created piece by piece over several years by Libby Wells, she has deconstructed her techniques and reconstructed these into a modular formula to offer a uniquely strategic approach to learning how to create fine line tattoos.

Libby believes in a **holistic and comprehensive** approach to learning, reflected in the wide array of topics covered and depth of knowledge offered within this course.





Three Part Process

Phase One – Theory study

You will be required to complete all theory training via the online portal. This will include in-depth studying at home and practical exercises that will be submitted for review, as you progress.

Phase Two - In-person masterclass

In-person 1-2-1 classes x 3 with Libby Wells. You will practice the physical application of tattoos on live models, demonstrating the knowledge learned during the theory training and practicing your new skills with the full support and direction of Libby.

Phase Three - Case studies

Once the masterclass is completed to a satisfactory standard, you will be ready to begin solo tattooing at your own premises, working as a junior tattoo artist while you gain experience in tattooing. You will be required to submit your tattoos for assessment during this 6 month period.

Requirements & Commitments

Entry Level for training

Entry level requirements for trainees Minimum 5 GCSEs, A-C grades, including (Art GCSE)
Submission of a professional artist portfolio of 10 pieces minimum.

Equipment, premises and documentation

Students will be required to supply their own equipment and make arrangements to work from an appropriate premises, who much hold the required licence, waste transfer note & insurance, this programme is constructed to teach students to work for themselves. All purchases, including training, need to be recorded for students personal tax accounting. A full list of recommended equipment will be provided in the course material.

Student responsibilities

Students will be required to complete all online studies provided; all assignments need to be passed in order to proceed. Students will be required to to attend in person masterclass' with Libby Wells. This is completed over three consecutive days, *dates will be confirmed*. Students will be required to submit case studies for final assessment.
